Mon collègue
Talking about school subjects/giving opinions and reasons/describing your timetable/describing your school day/talking about food

Mes passetemps
Talking about computers and mobiles/talking about which sports you play/talking about activities/saying what you like doing/describing what other people do

Ma zone
Talking about your town/village/giving directions/talking about where you go/asking someone to go somewhere/saying what you can do in town
