



# Frederic Chopin





## CONTEXT

Frederic Chopin (1810 – 1849) was a Polish composer of the Romantic era. Chopin predominantly composed solo piano pieces. In fact, all of his pieces include the piano, though he did compose some concertos with an orchestra and some pieces with vocalists.

Chopin composed over 230 pieces of music, though it is believed that some pieces from his early childhood have been lost!

Many of Chopin's pieces are evocative of the night time, especially pieces such as 'Nocturne in E Flat Major' – one of his most famous pieces!

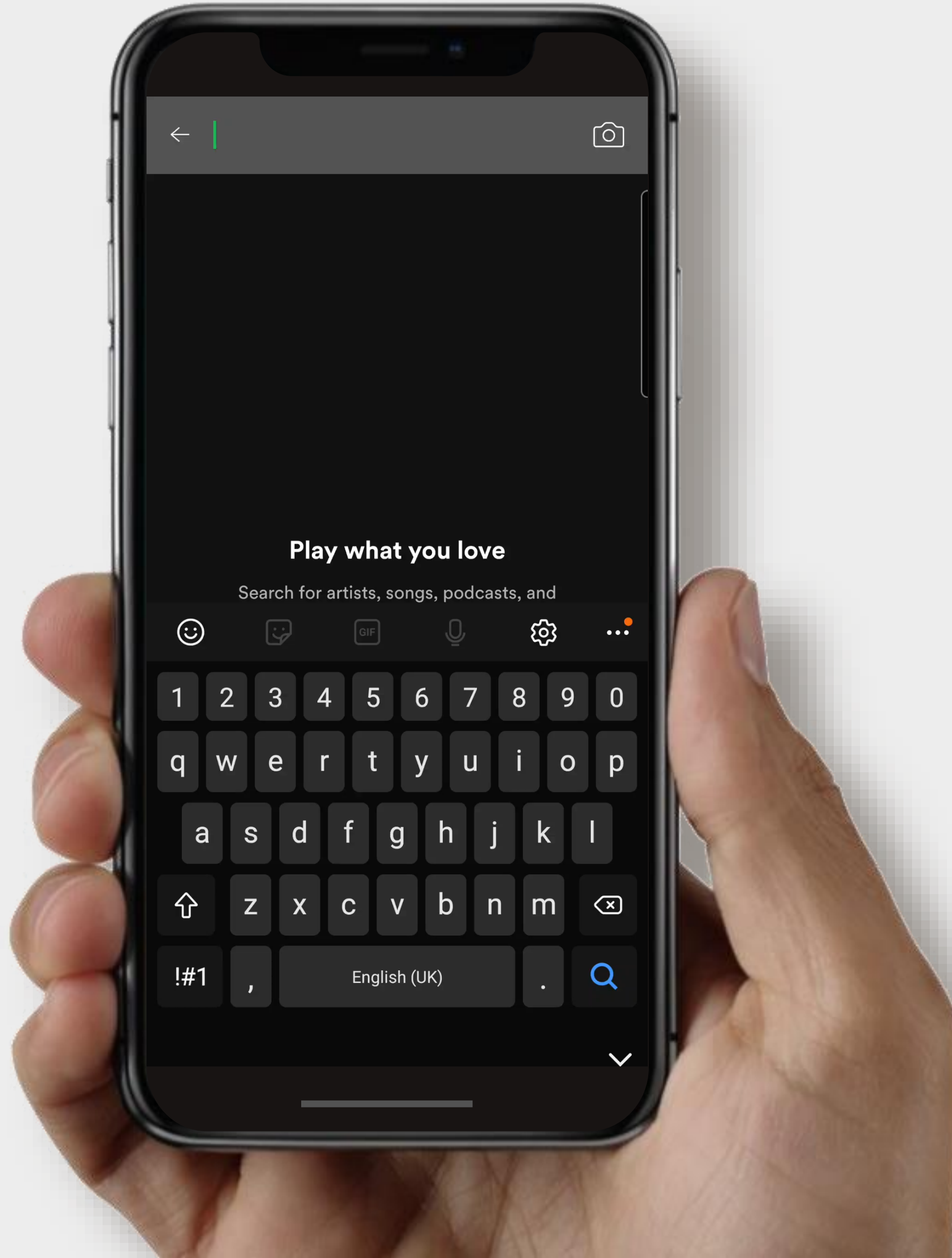
