















#### Musical Elements

'Smells Like Teen Spirit' is in 4/4 time. The tempo is allegro (117bpm), and the dynamics is largely forte throughout. The texture is homophonic. The form/structure is verse-chorus form.

#### Melody

The melody in 'Smells Like Teen Spirit' contains the notes of the F natural minor scale only (F G Ab Bb C Db Eb F):




Ab major scale "E shape," "D shape" and "C shape"

The melodic movement is mainly conjunct – notes move up or down by step – with a few disjunct notes in the first six beats of the verse. There is also evidence of sequences – repetition of a musical phrase at a different pitch – and imitation, as the electric guitar plays the vocal melody after the second chorus.

#### Chords

'Smells Like Teen Spirit' uses just four chords:



The song's signature riff is chordal, and uses these chords throughout: Fm - Bbm - Ab - Db. In the key of F minor, this is i - iv - bIII - bVI. All chords in this progression are diatonic, have a minim harmonic rhythm (two chords each bar), and are played as power chords (typical in Rock music).
